Sewers

Residents successfully petitioned most of the eastern side of the Village for Sanitary Sewer. January 12, 2011 was the final Public Hearing for the Lakes Area Special Assessment Sewer District. The construction of the sewer main will begin this winter and will run down Angola, Briar Ridge, Indiana, Newport, Solano, Paulette, Shankin, Shankin Ct. and Ventura streets. Residents on these streets may pay the costs in full or spread them over a 10 year period of time which will be added to the annual Village tax bill. Approximately the same time, Commerce Twp. will be installing an extension of the sewer main on South Commerce from Glengary to Wolverine Drive. The amount of soil disturbance will be minimal since this is directional bore construction. There will be a great deal of heavy equipment necessary, therefore, traffic stops may occur. Thank you for your patience during the construction.

Want to Hook Up to Sewer? If a sewer main is installed down your street, you may hook up immediately if you choose to pay the cost up front **or** participate in the upcoming Special Assessment District for hook up. The costs for the district will be developed based on the number of participants. These costs can be paid over a 10 year period of time on the annual Village tax bill. Visit Village Hall to sign a petition, DEADLINE FEBRUARY 23, 2011.

Winter Tips



- Parking on Village streets is prohibited November 1st through March 31st between 2:00 & 6:00 a.m.
- Remember it is illegal to push your driveway snow on the roadway.
- To reduce the amount of snow being pushed back into your driveway, pile snow from your driveway on the "downstream" side of the drive. If you stand in your driveway facing the street, the "downstream" side is to your right.
- Place trash cans and bags off the road. Plows are required to push snow back to the mailboxes.
- When following a salt truck be aware the driver may stop and back up at any time. Remember, if you cannot see the drivers face in the side mirror, they cannot see you. Please give the salt trucks room to work. When in doubt, stay back 100 feet.
- Never venture on the lake ice alone. Remember the ice thickness varies from spot to spot.
