EXOTIC ANIMAL OWNERSHIP APPEAL PROCESS

Chapter 606 of the Wolverine Lake Code of Ordinances outlines the appeal process for ownership of an exotic animal within the Village of Wolverine Lake. The Village Administrator is required to research the request, review the application, and make a recommendation to Village Council. This research will include consultation with the Wolverine Lake Police Department and any other safety officials deemed necessary. In the course of the research, the Administrator is permitted to ask additional questions of the applicant beyond what is included on the application.

Upon receipt of the application, the Administrator is permitted to take as much time as necessary to prepare the recommendation to Council. The Administrator's recommendation will be provided to Council during a regularly scheduled Council meeting. A hearing to review the application and the Administrator's recommendation will be held during that same meeting. Residents within 500 feet of the applicant's address will be notified not less than 15 days prior to the Council meeting.

Village Council will have the ability to approve, deny, or amend the recommendation of the Administrator. Their decision will be final.
