
TIKI NIGHT & FIREWORKS

Wolverine Lake, a 265-acre lake created from six small lakes in 1923, is the main street of the Village. The Village was incorporated as a "Home Rule Village" in 1954, and is 90% residential with over 4,000 residents.

The Village is in the Walled Lake School District, which is highly acclaimed for its award-winning programs and teachers. There are 3 high schools, 4 middle schools and 7 elementary schools.

As part of Commerce Township, the Village enjoys services provided by the Township, such as the library and fire protection, but maintains separate code enforcement and public works services. The Village also has its own police department and marine patrol.

Clara Miller Park provides tennis courts and ball diamonds, in addition to playground equipment for resident use. A Parks & Recreation Board plans annual activities such as Brunch with Santa, Bunny Lunch, Bus trips, and a Village Festival. An annual fishing tournament is planned by the Water Management Board, who also monitor Lake conditions and make recommendations to Council for treatment and safety,


